

Campground Park Rules

1. Check in with camp host BEFORE going up to campsites or parking in park
2. Speed Limit 5 MPH. Watch for kids!
3. **Pets must be on leash** and kept quiet. **Please clean up after your pet.** Aggressive animals must be on a leash at all times.
4. No filling or washing RVs. The park is on a well and we conserve water.
5. **Quiet Time is 11pm to 7am.** No excessive noise between these hours including generators or running engines.
6. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children.
7. Children under 12 years of age are required to wear life jackets when down at the river.
8. Campfires in fire pits only. Please do not move fire pits.
9. Please remove or clean off shoes before entering Lodge building or restroom/shower areas.
10. No motored vehicles or ATVs on grassy areas.
11. Check-out time is 1:00 pm unless other arrangements have been made.
12. No cannabis or cannabis-containing products allowed on property.
13. There is no trash services so **please pack out whatever you've packed in.**
14. We will recycle your cans and bottles. This helps support your park. Use the bag provided.

The Camp Host has the right to ask you to leave the park if you don't follow the camp rules.

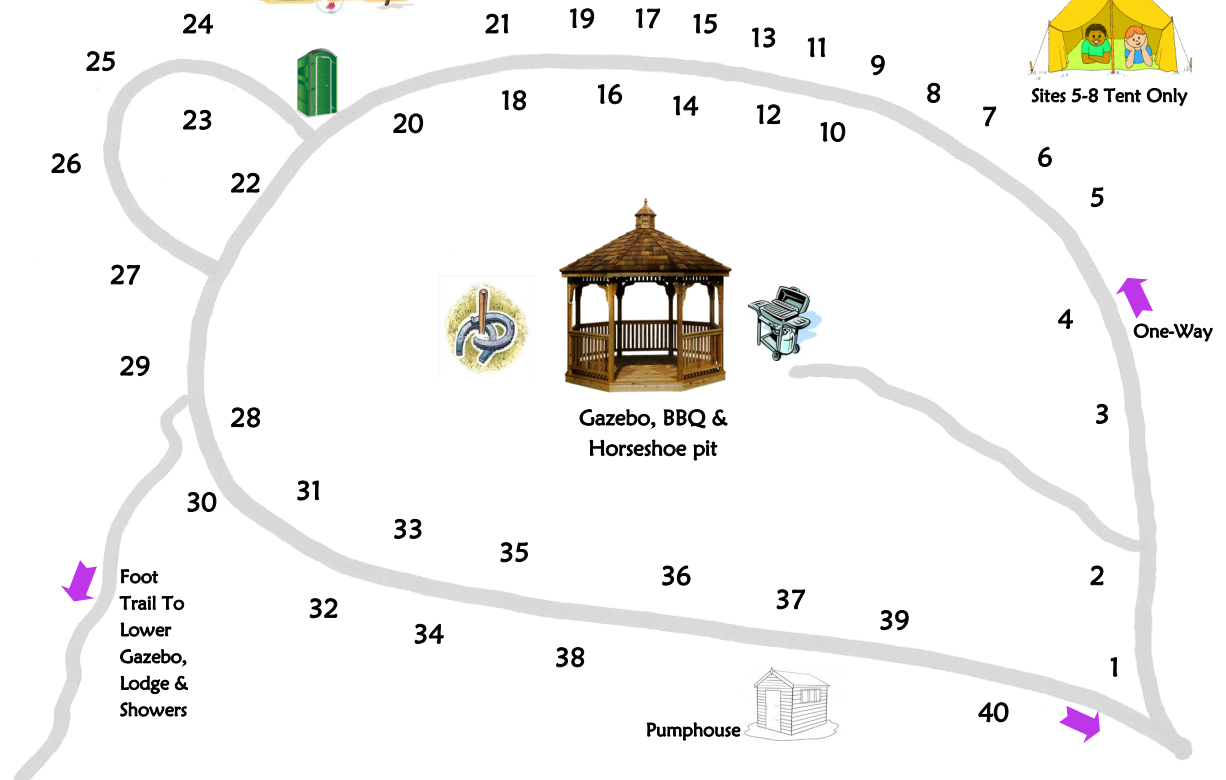

Non-Elks must be signed in and accompanied by an Elk member in Good Standing

We request that your first night's donation be remitted at the time of reservation in order to hold your camp site. Each site is limited to two tents or one RV + one tent

Event-Only Requirements

Facility and Event Fees

Club House	\$300 per day plus a \$250 refundable cleaning fee
Gazebos	\$100 per day plus a \$50 refundable cleaning fee

Insurance (for Events only)

You will be required to provide a Certificate of liability Insurance with a minimum of \$1,000,000 per occurrence naming The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks and Toledo Lodge #1664 as an Additional Insured. The policy must provide coverage for the duration of the rental of our facilities. Please ask for more information. Not required for camping only.

Alcohol Service (for Events only)

Any alcohol sold or provided at an event must be provided by Toledo Lodge #1664 and must be served by a licensed bartender also provided by Toledo Lodge #1664.

Fees for the facilities must be paid at the time of the reservation. An Elk member in good standing must sign, be present, and be responsible for the guests attending an event at our park.

Checks or Visa/MC will only be accepted from Members in Good Standing
